**FUNCTIONAL REGIONS:** Local and regional development, less inequality between places

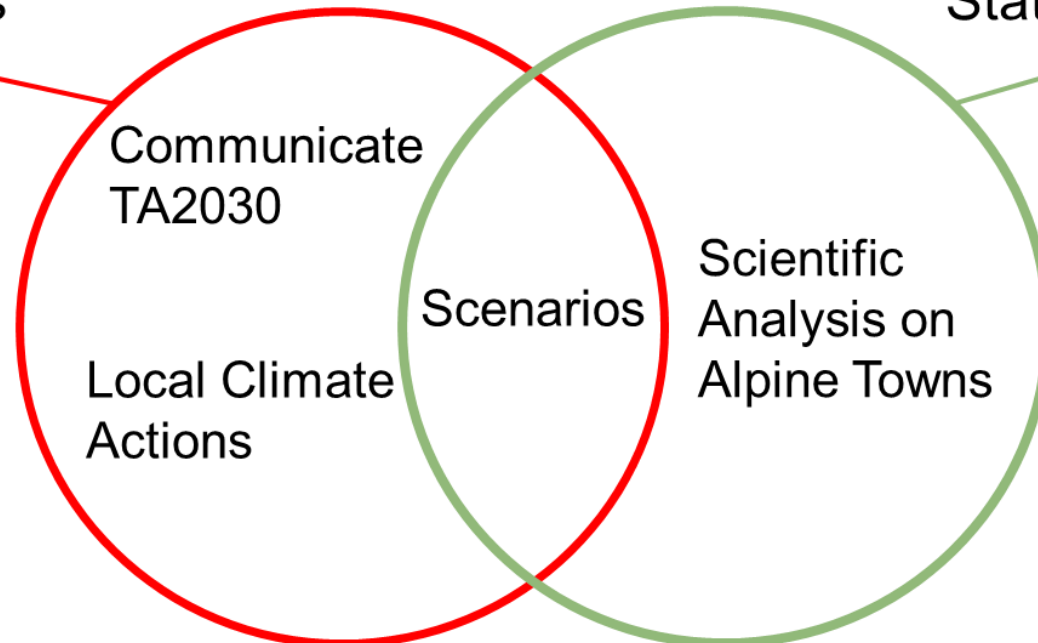

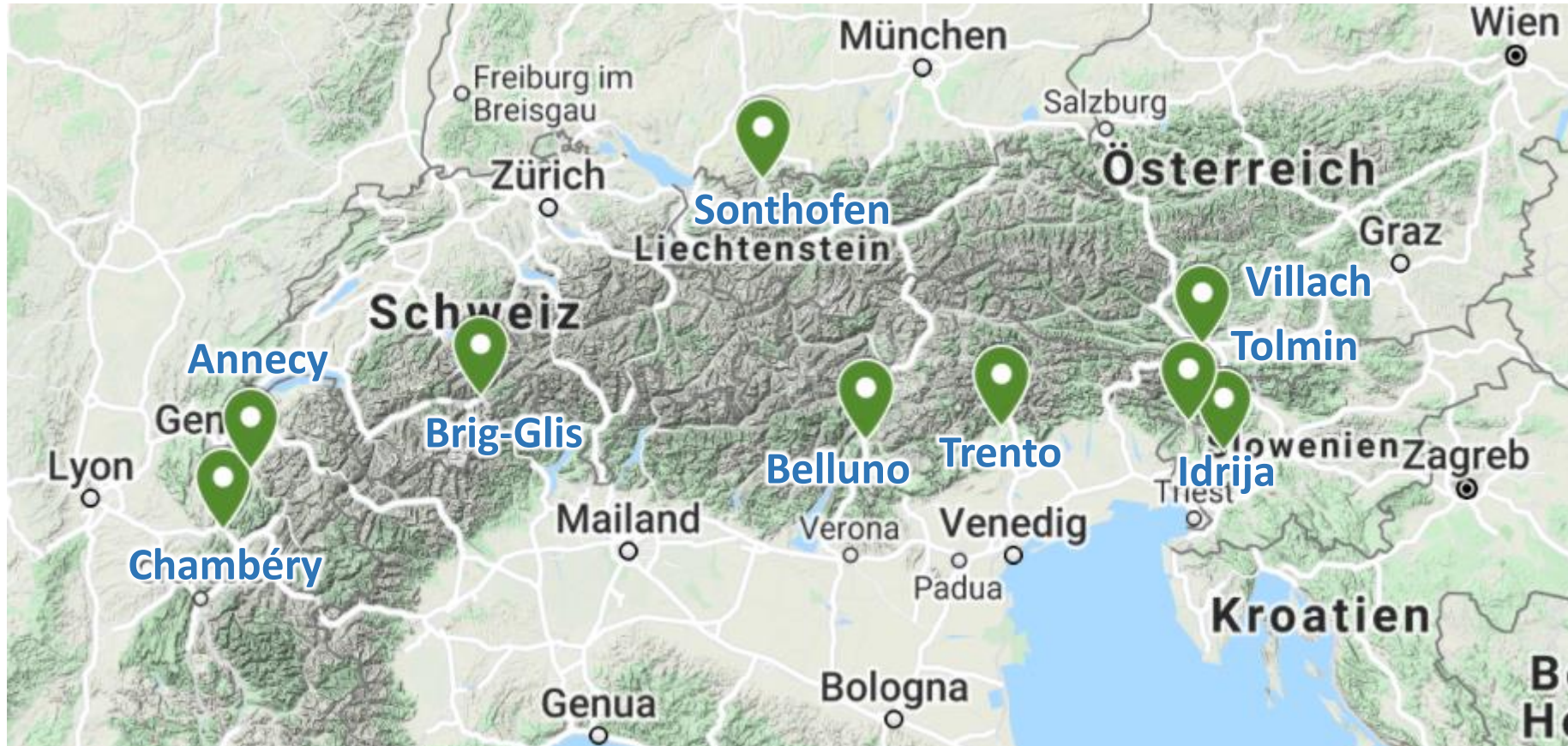
