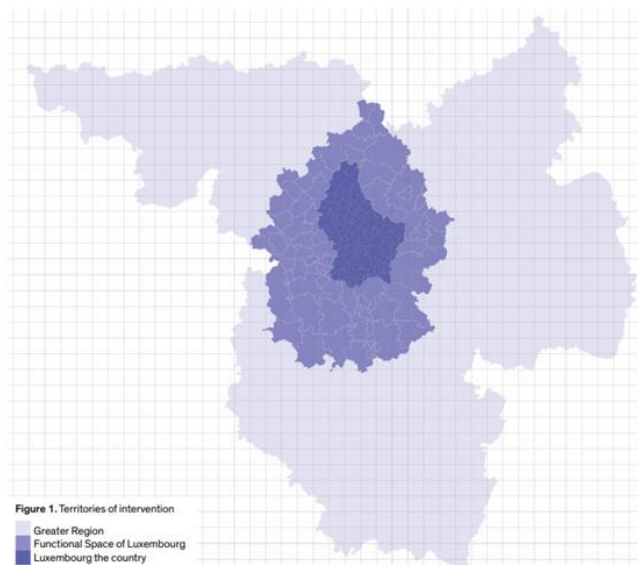

## □ Process called **TRANSITION**:

- A cooperative competition with 10 international expert teams developing territorial visions and implementation strategies for the ecological transition of the cross-border functional region of Luxembourg until 2050.

## □ Key questions:

- How to develop a joint territorial vision for the cross-border functional area and how to translate it into concrete projects on both sides of the border?
- How to approach the cross-border dimension of decarbonisation and resilience?

- ❑ **TA2030 objectives:** Integration beyond borders, Healthy environment, Functional regions
- ❑ **Goals:**
  - Share the methodology of this process and inspire its transfer
  - Discuss the challenges of cross-border spatial planning in relation with the ecological transition
- ❑ **Outputs:**
  - Guidance note (2-3 pages) for the potential transfer of the methodology: Description of the different steps of the process and lessons learnt.
- ❑ **Timeline:**
  - Phase 1: Mutual learning and sharing process (03/2021–02/2022) – 4 virtual meetings
    - Presenting the methodology and results of the process. Engaging in a critical exchange with partners.
  - Phase 2: Development of a guidance note (02/2022–12/2022) – 3 virtual meetings
    - Drafting the guidance note for the potential transfer of the methodology.
  - Final conference on cross-border territorial visioning (tbc)

- The Pilot Action is primarily aimed at the local and regional level (in a cross-border dimension):
  - Decarbonisation and resilience at the local and regional level
  - Cooperating in (cross-border) functional regions

  - Committee of the Regions officially representing local/regional authorities
